Thank you for providing us with the relevant information on the control measures taken against the avian influenza outbreak in Lithuania.


I am hereby pleased to inform you that the import suspension of meat and egg products derived from poultry (chicken, quail, ostrich, turkey, pheasant, guinea fowl and birds classified into anseriformes order) from Marijampolė County has been lifted as of 1 July 2024, as a result of the assessment of the information provided.

Therefore, following commodities from Marijampolė County have become eligible to be exported to Japan.

- a) Poultry meat derived from poultry slaughtered on and after 1 July 2024, and their products
- b) Eggs laid on and after 1 July 2024, and their products
